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| 'I am an Artist' | 4-10 ages |
| Age for Children | All kinds of paper, different coloured paint, brushes, <br> cardboard box, fabric |
| Environment, Materials | Children learn how to mix the colours to get the colours <br> that are not available e.g. White and Red= Pink. They also <br> learn to paint on different materials. |
| Teachers Support for the Child | The teacher explains the characteristics of each material <br> and encourages the children to mix and match. The <br> teacher is there to support the children, especially if they <br> need it. |
| Children's Activities (Planning, Tasks, | The children need to choose a friend/another child and <br> paint a portrait of them. They need to look closely and <br> include all the correct features such as, hair length and <br> style, eye colour, skin colour, face shape etc. For the <br> brown colour they can mix red and green and for orange <br> its, yellow and red. They did this during afterschool club <br> and they use different types of brushes to get thin lines <br> and thick lines. They used the cardboard box as a treasure <br> box by painting it and collecting various items. |
