## "The European Child: Learning by doing the 3 C's-Connect, Construct and Create" Plan of Activities

Title of Activity 'I am an Artist'	Portrait Using Paint
Age for Children	4-10 ages
Environment, Materials	All kinds of paper, different coloured paint, brushes, cardboard box, fabric
Expected Results	Children learn how to mix the colours to get the colours that are not available e.g. White and Red= Pink. They also learn to paint on different materials.
Teachers Support for the Child	The teacher explains the characteristics of each material and encourages the children to mix and match. The teacher is there to support the children, especially if they need it.
Children's Activities (Planning, Tasks, Evaluation)	The children need to choose a friend/another child and paint a portrait of them. They need to look closely and include all the correct features such as, hair length and style, eye colour, skin colour, face shape etc. For the brown colour they can mix red and green and for orange its, yellow and red. They did this during afterschool club and they use different types of brushes to get thin lines and thick lines. They used the cardboard box as a treasure box by painting it and collecting various items.
Looking for answers to questions	What do we use brushes for? What colours makes this colour? What features do everybody have on their face? Why do we use different brushes? Why do we mix colours? What else can we use paint on? What things would you like to collect and put in your treasure box and why?
